

**Excalibur Hotel & Casino
Mid Day Slot Tournament
Official Rules/Regulations**

Promotional Period:

- The Mid Day Slot Tournaments will be held each Thursday through Sunday from 2pm to 5pm, last play time for a session is 4:30 p.m., beginning February 26, 2009 in the Excalibur Hotel/Casino rotunda.

Eligibility:

- The Mid Day Slot Tournaments are open to the public.
- Participants must be a member of MGM MIRAGE Players Club
- Two ways to enter
 - \$20 (Twenty dollars) entry fee per person per session.
 - Patrons that received an invitation to this event will receive one free entry. This entry coupon will print at the front desk upon check-in and is valid for one 10 minute play time.
- Free entry to this Slot Tournament is based on the level of your carded play per visit.
- Other free entries may be issued in additional marketing offers based on casino activity.
- All Players Club rules/regulations apply.
- Invited guests for a free entry must book a room under the designated offer
- All players must be at least 21 years of age to participate.
- Daily winners will have until 5:30 p.m., on their winning day, to collect their prize or the prize will be forfeited.

Tournament Registration and timing:

- Patrons will register for a session in the tournament area located in the rotunda. The last play time for a session is 4:30 p.m.
- The Mid Day Slot Tournaments are open from 2pm until 5pm during the valid dates of the promotion.
- Each guest will register at the tournament area (give free entry coupon or cash entry)
- Seating is based on machine availability per session time
- Upon entering the tournament area each guest will draw for a machine number and go to the corresponding machine.
- An announcement will start each session
- Additional session times can be bought for a cash entry of \$20 each

Tournament Rules:

- Each paid or complimentary entrant will play 1 (one) ten minute session.
- Credits are automatically compiled by the machines. All slot tournament machines are operated by pressing the spin button. No coins and/or slot tokens are required. The machines will automatically stop at the end of the session. All contestants will be playing the exact same machine type.
- No smoking is permitted in the tournament area.
- In the event of a machine malfunction, a tournament official must be notified immediately. If an entrant experiences a machine malfunction creating an unfair result, the first machines score will be considered void. Only the score on the next machine will be considered as a session score.
- Entrants are to remain seated until a Tournament Representative records their session score. Entrants will verify and sign for their score.
- The top ten point earners will be posted on the tournament scoring board located in the tournament area. The top ten denoted on the winners board will fluctuate during tournament play as high scores are attained.
- All final tie scores for each winning place will share the tournament prize equally. (I.e. if two persons tie for first place they will equally share the first and second place prizes).
- The first place winner must present valid photo identification and social security number to the Cage to receive their winning tournament payment. The first place winner(s) are required to complete and sign the necessary tax paperwork and the Excalibur Winner's Form in order to receive payment.
- Second and third place winners will be issued a coupon to redeem at the Players Club desk in order to have their FREEPLAY adjusted to their Players Club account
